How to get from the Pulkovo Airport to the hotel

The most convenient and safe way to get from the Pulkovo airport directly to the hotel is to use official airport taxi (Taxi Pulkovo). Taxi Pulkovo counters are located at Arrivals hall on the first floor. You can pay for your taxi by credit card/cash at the Taxi Pulkovo counter or by cash to the driver at the end of a ride. The cost of the economy class ride from the airport to the Central district (where all the hotels and the venue are located) is ₺1050. See also <http://www.pulkovoairport.ru/en/transport/taxi/>.

If you are looking for some exotics, a bus/subway transportation is also possible. At the airport take the city bus number 39. The bus stop is in front of the Arrivals hall exit. There are three kinds of buses: city bus (39), express city bus (39Ex) and Minivan taxi (K39). They all have the Moskovskaya metro station as the stop and cost ₺40.

At the Moskovskaya metro station, take a subway train to the Tekhnologicheskyy Institute metro station (Parnas direction). At the Tekhnologicheskyy Institute metro station cross the platform and take a subway train to the Chernyshevskaya metro station (Devyatkino direction). Entrance to the subway (you can buy token in tickets window inside) — ₺45.

After leaving the vestibule of the Chernyshevskaya metro station, turn left, then almost immediately turn right and turn left at the first crossing. Go along Furshtatskaya St., on the right side. The **Austrian Yard Hotel** is located at 16 Furshtatskaya St. The **Solo Hotel** (2 Furshtatskaya St.) and the **Liteiniy Hotel** (12 Liteyny Ave.) are located at the corner of Furshtatskaya St. and Liteyny Ave. To reach the **Art Hotel Mokhovaya** (27–29 Mokhovaya St.), turn left from Furshtatskaya St. to Liteyny Ave., go along Liteyny Ave., turn right to Pestelya St. and then turn left at the first crossing to Mokhovaya St. Each hotel

is at most 10 minutes walk from the venue of the Workshop (European University at St. Petersburg, 1 Shpalernaya St.).

How to get from the Moskovsky Railway Station to the hotel

Directly from the railway station, enter the Ploshchad Vosstaniya metro station. Take a subway train to the Chernyshevskaya metro station (this is the next stop in the Devyatkinno direction). For the directions how to get from the Chernyshevskaya metro station to the hotel, see above.

How to get from the Finlyandsky Railway Station to the hotel

Directly from the railway station, enter the Ploshchad Lenina metro station. Take a subway train to the Chernyshevskaya metro station (this is the next stop in the Prospekt Veteranov direction). For the directions how to get from the Chernyshevskaya metro station to the hotel, see above.

LUNCHESES

For the presenters included in the Workshop program we provide two lunches (May 31 and June 1, **Bretzel** Restaurant, 4 Tchaikovskogo St.) and a conference dinner (May 31, **Serenada** Banquet Hall at the **VINO&VODA** Restaurant, 17 Tchaikovskogo St.). However, there are some other nice places near the venue and the hotels where you can have lunch or dinner.

Restaurants and cafes very close to the EUSP (3-5 min. walk)

1. **Bretzel** Restaurant, 4 Tchaikovskogo St.
2. **VINO&VODA** Restaurant, 17 Tchaikovskogo St.
3. **The Bar**, 6 Gagarinskaya St.
4. French cafe «**Chez Jules**», 16 Gangutskaya St.
5. Family restaurant «**Swan-Geese**», 16 Gagarinskaya St.
6. Cafe «**Books and coffee**», 20 Gagarinskaya St.

Restaurants and cafes near the EUSP (10-20 min. walk)

1. **Gastrobar Duo**, 8a Kirochnaya St., phone: +7 812 994 54 43. Opened evenings only, there is a necessity to book. However, food and wine are great there.
2. **WongKarWine**, 14 Fontanka River embankment; phone +7 921 943 19 30. They have food in Asian style, good selection of wine, some cider and beer. Very tasty. Preferably book in advance.
3. Cafe «**Amarcord**», 49 Zhukovskogo St., phone +7 812 948 20 05. Excellent Italian home-like cooking. It is better to book in advance. The chef is Italian.
4. «**Podpisnye izdaniya**», 57 Liteyny Ave., phone +7 812 273 50 53. If by chance you are interested in a good bookshop and a very good coffee (if you buy books for more than ₺1000 one coffee is free for you).
5. **Birch**, 3 Kirochnaya St., phone +7 911 920 31 65. Quite new but already famous and renowned restaurant.
6. **Wine and Khachapuri**, 56 Mayakovskogo St., phone +7 911 217 85 41. A very neat place with Georgian food.

SIGHTSEEINGS

The renowned **State Hermitage Museum** is one of the largest and most-respected museums in the world. Situated along the beautiful Neva River, this St. Petersburg museum comprises six impressive buildings and hosts over three million items. As one of the city's most prestigious attractions, the Hermitage is a must-see for anyone visiting St. Petersburg. Please take note that the Hermitage is closed on Mondays.

Located on the bank of the Neva River, where you find the estuary of the Fontanka River, is the delightful **Summer Garden**. Locally known as Letniy Sad, this gem of a garden was founded in 1704. It was Peter the Great who ordered the garden built, and it is said that he was also personally involved in the planning of it. Not much is left in St. Petersburg since the time of its foundation, and the Summer Garden is one of the places where one can feel the atmosphere of Peter's time. The **Summer Palace**, situated in the garden, is one of the earliest monuments of architecture in St. Petersburg. It was built according to the project by Domenico Trezzini in 1714 and has never been rebuilt since that time. Nowadays, it contains the Cabin (cabinet de curiosités) of Peter the Great.

The Church of Our Savior on Spilled Blood, to use its full name, is a stunning piece of religious architecture nestled on the banks of the Griboedova Channel in St. Petersburg. The church can be found in many English tourist guides under various names, but is commonly shortened to the Church on Spilt Blood. From the Fontanka River, it is easy to spot the church with combination of multi-coloured and gold onion-shaped domes that dominate the roof and you will know when you have found it.
